




A Letter from Our Founder

Precautions

- Garden top will get warm. Do not place items that generate heat (appliances, candles, etc.), items that are sensitive to heat, or insulating material on top of garden.
- Only place the power supplies where indicated in this manual.
- If an electronic part gets wet, immediately unplug the garden and ensure the part is thoroughly dry before continuing use. If water damage is significant, please discontinue use and reach out to Rise Gardens Support at support@risegardens.com to report the incident.
- Unplug from power before cleaning, maintenance, assembly, disassembly.
- Unplug from power before connecting or disconnecting cables and electronic components.
- Do not touch any of the electronics with wet hands.
- Cap all exposed electronic connectors when not in use.
- Supervise children around the garden.

- All electrical connectors must be fully connected before the garden is plugged into power.
- For indoor use only.
- Use only with Rise accessories and replacement components.
- If electronics are damaged, unplug and do not use. Reach out to Rise Gardens Support at support@risegardens.com to report the incident.
- Keep the power cord away from other sources of heat. Keep power cord away from walkways where it might become a trip hazard.
- Do not use a garden around aerosol sprays or concentrated oxygen.
- Light modules and power supplies may be detached for replacement.
- To avoid damaging electrical cords, do not pinch or bend sharply.


If you are building a double- or triple-level garden, set any Extension packages aside for now.



Unpack Cabinet




Smart strip/Nursery box

a. Set cabinet on its back.






O4 Unpack Tray



Install Uprights

- a. Set cabinet on its feet.
- b. Insert 4x upright into each corner of cabinet.

c. Secure with each upright with 2x screw.

Assemble Pump

a. Unbox pump and mounting brackets.



Attach pump tube and mounting brackets and attach pump filter.




c. Rinse assembly before use.




O7Install Pump

a. Install pump assembly in water tank.



b. Place water tank back into cabinet.




Route pump cable through water tank opening and out bottom of cabinet.




Install Outer Tray


a. Lower outer tray onto cabinet.
Circular plumbing holes of outer tray are on left side.



b. Secure with 4x screws.



Retrieve Plumbing




Install Plumbing

Place water conduit into the two circular holes on left side of outer tray.

Verify that water conduit is positioned above holes in water tank. Flexible tip is on front side of garden.

b. Return water tray to outer tray. Ensure it is fully seated.

Note that water tray tubes slot into water conduit.






Steps 11-16 only apply to double- and triple-level gardens.




If building a single-level garden, skip to step 17.

11 Unpack Extension Box




Install Upright Extensions

a. Attach 2x upright extensions to uprights.





b. Secure with 4x screws.






Install Outer Tray

a. Lower outer tray onto upright extensions. Circular plumbing holes of outer tray are on left side.



b. Secure with 4x screws.






Install Extension Plumbing

a. Place plumbing adapter into lowest-level water tray.


b. Insert 2x extension pipes through the circular holes in the outer tray above and into the plumbing adapter.

Use long pipes first.









c. Return water tray to outer tray. Ensure it is fully seated.

Mount Power Supply

a. Place power supply on mounting screws on right wall of cabinet.

"Output" faces up. "Input" faces down.

b. Rotate paddles to secure.

- E Feed output cable (cylindrical connector) out hole in back of cabinet.
- Feed input cable (three prong) out hole in bottom of **cabinet**.



Add Second Extension to a Triple-Level Garden

If building a triple-level garden, repeat steps 11-15 with the third level.

If building a double-level garden, move on to step 17.

For the second extension, use the small **extension pipes**.




Install Top Shelf

Align top shelf and lower onto uprights.
Ensure that cable is on the right-hand side.




b. Secure with 4x screws.





Connect Tubing to Pump

a. Uncoil **tubing** and feed into the raised hole on top **water tray** until the short segment rests in groove.



Push firmly.





Cover Water Tray(s)

a. Place tray lids on top of water tray(s).




b. Place service door(s) on left side.

Unpack Smart Strip and Nursery



Connect Lights

Plug the cable from power supply into top shelf and screw in to secure.

Note light connectors are keyed. If the plug does not fit initially, gently rotate plug until the keys line up and the plug is able to be inserted into the socket. Do not force the plug as this may break or bend the connector.

b. If building a double- or triple-level, connect additional light cable(s) from outer trays.



Manage Cables and Connect Pump

a. Use included hook-and-loop ties to secure and bundle excess cable.

(Back view)

b. Plug cable from pump into pump power supply.



Tip Prevention

A kit with two straps is provided to secure the garden to residential wall studs.

To use the kits, loop the metal cable around each rear **upright**, just under the **top shelf**.

Position the garden such that the cable is not loose.

If a stud is not accessible, use an anchor appropriate to your wall material and rated for at least 25lbs.



Apply on both sides of the garden.




Water Dampeners

A foam water dampener is provided with each extension hardware kit in order to reduce splashing.

Single-level gardens do not require a water dampener. Double-level gardens use one dampener and triple-level gardens use two.


Each water dampener inserts into the gap between plumbing adapter and extension pipe. The wall of extension pipe rests within the slit on water dampener.

Each water dampener is intended to fall out in the event of a clog. If it is falling out prematurely, try pushing water dampener slightly further in.




Plug Electronics into Smart Strip

a. Plug power supply(s) into smart strip. Remove socket covers, as needed.




b. Plug pump power supply into smart strip.

IMPORTANT: place smart strip behind or to the right of garden. Do not place smart strip underneath or inside garden. Do not place smart strip immediately to the left of garden, which is where water is added.



Powering On

a. Fill the water tank about halfway.




b. Plug smart strip into wall. Press button on smart strip to turn it on.

The lights should turn on and the **pump** should start running.

IMPORTANT: To enable the automatic timer, connect smart strip with the Rise Gardens app.

IMPORTANT: Monitor the garden for a few minutes to ensure there are no leaks.





Troubleshooting Table

Structure	Uprights will not assemble	Bend edges of joint inwards slightly. If this is not effective, reach out to support.risegardens.com.
Structure	Part is missing/damaged	Reach out to support.risegardens.com
Structure	Door does not close	Push water tank back slightly.
Water	Water leak	Check overlap of joint between water tray and drain conduit or extension pipes. Check that water tray is fully seated in outer tray.
Water	Water is noisy	Adjust position of water tank such that falling water from drain conduit adheres to slanted wall. Check that water dampeners are properly installed in plumbing adapters.
Water	Pump is noisy	Adjust position of pump in water tank.
Power	Lights do not turn on	Toggle power button on smart strip. Try plugging power supplies directly into a wall outlet
Power	Lights do not turn on/off automatically (not on timer)	The smart strip must be configured through the app and conected to wifi (2.4GHz) for the timer to function

Warranty and Returns

Limited Warranty Policy - Indoor Gardens

All our Indoor Gardens come with a 3-year warranty for hardware components and 3-year warranty on electronic components against defects in workmanship and materials.

To be eligible for a warranty replacement you must have proof of purchase (order number or email confirming purchase) and be the original owner of the Indoor Garden.

Damage or equipment failure due to normal wear and tear, improper or negligent assembly, maintenance, accident, abuse, improper or abnormal use, and relocation is not covered under the warranty.



Return Policy - Indoor Gardens

If you find yourself unsatisfied with a recent purchase, you have 90 days from the time of delivery to return your purchase. To be eligible for the return of a product other than a Garden, your item must be unused and in the same condition that you received it. Perishable goods such as seed pods & nutrients are not eligible for return. Please reach out to our Support Team for any return inquiry.

To complete any return, we require a receipt or proof of purchase. All items must be returned in original packaging. If you do not have original packaging, you will need to purchase it from Rise Gardens.

For returns not related to a warranty claim, customers are responsible for the return shipping cost. The cost of shipping labels and packaging kits provided by Rise Gardens will be deducted from your refund. Any eligible refund will be issued only once the returned item is received by Rise Gardens. Please do not send your purchase back to the manufacturer.



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
