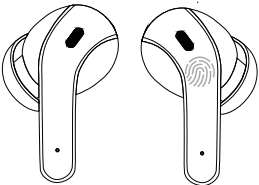

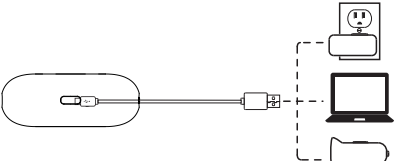

1. Fully charge the earbuds and charging case.



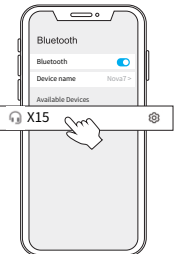
2. Choose the right angle and eartips.

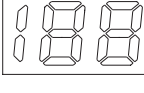

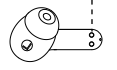
