


To reduce the risk of electric shock, this plug is intended to fit into a polarized outlet one way only. If it fits into an outlet only one way, it is the correct way. Do not attempt to defeat this safety feature. To reduce the risk of fire or electric shock, do not use this appliance with any other-rate speed power device.</p> <p>Before Using</p> <p>1. Make sure the voltage indicated on the appliance corresponds to the voltage of the power source to connect the appliance. Other electrical appliances used simultaneously may cause the socket to overheat or catch fire.</p> <p>2. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent, or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.</p>	<p>SAFETY</p> <p>During Transport Before transporting the device, be sure to turn it off and unplug it from power.</p> <p>Before Using</p> <p>1. This device will not work if the filter cover is not securely closed.</p> <p>2. Always keep the purifier at least 19.7 inches away from the wall and other obstructions.</p> <p>While Cleaning</p> <p>1. Always unplug the power cord before cleaning or performing maintenance or transporting the appliance.</p> <p>2. Frequently clean the outer surface of the filter so that it's free of dust and debris. This will help the filter to reduce the growth of bacteria.</p> <p>3. Frequently clean the air inlet so that it's free of dust and debris. This will help prevent the air flow from decreasing.</p> <p>4. When using for an extended period of time, cover the air inlet on the top of the air purifier. This will help prevent dust from entering the purifier and keep the internal components clean.</p> <p>While Powered</p> <p>1. Please use the power cord and socket according to the following instructions to avoid fire, electric shock or damage.</p> <p>2. Always unplug the power cord before performing maintenance or transporting the appliance.</p> <p>3. Make sure the filter cover is not securely closed before plugging in the power cord.</p> <p>4. Do not use the purifier near open flames including incense burners, lit cigarettes, lighters, lighters, and broilers.</p> <p>5. Do not use the purifier in extremely hot or warm areas such as bathrooms and saunas.</p> <p>6. The purifier is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they are supervised by a person responsible for their safety.</p> <p>7. The fan speed will intelligently adjust based on the real-time indoor AQI concentration.</p> <p>Fan Speed Cycles through fan speeds from slowest to fastest: Min, Mid, Max, and Off.</p> <p>Sleep Mode Turns on Sleep Mode. The display screen will turn off and the purifier will automatically turn off.</p> <p>Filter Replacement Press and hold the A + B buttons at the same time for 3s to reset the filter replacement timer.</p> <p>Child Lock With the purifier powered on, press and hold A + B at the same time for 3s to reset the Wi-Fi connection for the appliance.</p> <p>Display Press and hold the A + C buttons at the same time for 3s to enable and disable Child Lock.</p>	<p>TOUCH BUTTONS</p> <p>Filter Replacement, Wi-Fi Reset, Child Lock</p> <p>On/Off, Auto Mode, Fan Speed, Sleep</p>
<p>GETTING STARTED</p> <p>Remove the Packaging</p> <p>1. Turn the air purifier over. Remove the orange filter cover from the bottom of the appliance.</p> <p>2. Put the filter from the original packaging into the filter cover. Make sure the filter is correctly seated.</p> <p>3. Position the filter cover on the top of the air purifier and reinforce the filter cover with the orange filter.</p> <p>WHERE TO PLACE YOUR PURIFIER</p> <p>For best performance, position the air purifier so that it is at least 19.7 inches from the wall and other obstructions while in use.</p> <p>USING WYZE SMART AIR PURIFIER</p> <p>Basic Operation</p> <p>1. Plug in the power cord before performing maintenance on the air purifier.</p> <p>2. Turn on the air purifier. The default setting is Auto Mode.</p> <p>3. Tap the Fan Speed button to cycle between speeds.</p> <p>4. Tap the On/Off button again to turn the purifier off.</p> <p>Sleep Mode</p> <p>Sleep Mode turns off the display screen and sets the fan speed to the lowest setting.</p> <p>1. Tap the Sleep Mode icon on the display screen and set the fan speed to the lowest setting.</p> <p>2. Tap the Sleep Mode icon again to turn off the fan.</p> <p>Child Lock</p> <p>Child Lock prevents the current setting from being changed. The touch buttons will not respond when tapped, and a lock icon will be displayed on the screen.</p> <p>1. Press and hold the A + B for 3 seconds to turn on Child Lock. Repeat to disable Child Lock.</p> <p>Timer</p> <p>Use the Wyze app to start a timer for the air purifier. The timer indicator light will be shown on the display screen.
