




**Note:** In order to maintain the performance and reliability of the projector, please leave at least 30cm of space around the projector.

#### **INSTALLATION AND DEBUGGING**

#### 1. Projector Installation

Place the projector on a firm, level base.




#### 2. Focus Adjustment

When the image is blurred, press **F+ or F-** button on the remote to adjust the focus to improve the clarity of the image. If you cannot obtain satisfactory clarity through adjustment, please try to move the projector forward or backward.

Warm Tips: Click F- for larger display image and Click F+ for smaller image.





#### 3. Keystone Correction

#### Electric Keystone Adjustment [Max ±50°]

Electrically adjust the Keystone correction under [Menu] - [Adjust] - Vertical Keystone] - [Direction keys for ◄/► adjustment.

Note: The side projection angle of the projector should not exceed ±15°. It's recommended to use horizontally.




#### 4. ZOOM Setting

Go to Home Page--[Setting]--[Option]--[window zoom]--[Zoom+/Zoom-]. The projection screen can be zoomed from 100% to 50% without moving the projector distance. Press Direction keys for ◄/► to set the value needed and click Reset to the original image.

#### SOUNDBAR SETTINGS

#### 1. Picture Settings

Set up Contrast, Brightness, Color, Sharpness under Settings –Image Mode, User Mode; Switch color temperature to medium, warm, user and cool to meet different

usage.



Warm Tips: Warm Mode is good for video display quality and Cool Mode is ideal for Image Display

#### 2. Sound Settings

Set up sound patterns of Standard, Music, Movie, Sports and User Mode; Balance is to balance the sound of the left and right channel of the speaker.



#### 3. Bluetooth Settings

- \* Go to Home Page--Setting--Select Bluetooth and press OK to turn on Bluetooth,
- \* Click Search Bluetooth and choose the device to be paired,
- \* Select the Back key to exit after successfully Connected.



Notice: It's NOT supported to connect with smart-phones via Bluetooth to realize screen sync.

#### 4. Option Settings

For OSD Language, Factory Reset, Auto Sleep, OSD Timer, Window Zoom, Video Delay and Version information Settings, you can set them up under Option part.

#### 4.2 Video Delayed Function


When you connect the Soundbar to watch video programs and notice that the actions in the video are significantly out of sync with the audio output, you can optimize it as follows: Use the keys on the remote control to operate.

Press "Settings Video Delay OK" to adjust the "Video delay" data. The current delay data (0 to 800) will be displayed on the right side of the screen. Use the up and down keys on the remote control to adjust the video delay value to optimize the synchronization of the actions in the video and the audio output until the desired effect is achieved.

#### 4.3 Auto Sleep

The projector will automatically power off if there is no audio or video playback for 30 minutes.

#### CHARGING THE SOUNDBAR

When playing from battery power the product will turn off after 15 minutes of not playing audio to conserve the battery charge.


When plugged into a charging source the product will remain on until you turn the power off.

For maximum playtime, fully charge the battery in the soundbar.

#### IMPORTANT: Before first use, charge for 4 hours.

 Connect the included USB-C cord into the USB-C port of the product. Connect the other end of the cord into a USB AC adapter and then into a power outlet.

#### To Prolong Battery Life:

- If the product is stored fully charged, re-charge every 3 months; not to exceed 6 months between charges.
- If the unit is stored with no charge, do not exceed 15 days without charging.



#### **Projector and Soundbar Connection**



- Turn on your projector and soundbar
- Plug one end of the 3.5mm stereo audio cable into the AUX IN jack on the speaker.
- Plug the other end of the audio cable into the LINE OUT jack on the projector.
- Make sure both ends of the audio cable are fully plugged in.
- The sound from the projector should now play through the soundbar.

#### **AURACAST**

- 1. Ensure that only one speaker acts as the transmitter in the same environment.
- 2. Transmitter: When the speaker is connected via Bluetooth and playing music, briefly press the "Auracast & BT" button. The speaker will emit "Auracast pairing", indicating it has entered Auracast transmission mode. Press the button again to exit, accompanied by "Auracast disconnected" tones.
- **3. Receiver:** When the speaker is not connected via Bluetooth, briefly press the "Auracast & BT" button. The speaker will emit a "Auracast pairing" and the white LED will illuminate, indicating it has entered Auracast receiver mode. After the speaker connects successfully, play the prompt tone "Auracast connected". Press again to exit, signaled by "Auracast disconnected" tones and the Bluetooth LED flashing.
- **4. When the Auracast** is successfully established, all receivers will synchronously play the same audio as the transmitter.

#### **Dust Removal from Projector**

Cleaning the dust - proof net of the projector can prevent dust from clogging and affecting heat dissipation and projection effects. The methods are as follows:

#### **Tools Preparation:**

- Flat head screwdriver (used when prying open the dust proof net)
- Soft bristle brush (such as an old toothbrush)
- Hairdryer (cold air setting) or compressed air can
- Clean water (suitable for some washable dust proof nets)

#### Cleaning steps:

1. Power - off operation

First, turn off the projector and disconnect the power supply, and wait for the machine body to cool down (to avoid burns).

2. Locate the dust - proof net

It is usually on the side, back or bottom of the projector. There is an obvious grid - shaped cover plate, and some models are marked with the word "FILTER".

3. Remove the dust - proof net

Pry open the dust-proof net with a flat-head screwdriver






4. Clean the dust - proof net

For light dust: Gently brush off the surface dust with a soft - bristle brush, or blow it clean with a hairdryer on the cold air setting from a distance of 10 - 15 cm.

For thick dust: If the dust - proof net is washable (check the instruction manual), rinse it with clean water and let it dry (avoid direct sunlight), and reinstall it after it is completely dry.



5. Reinstall the dust - proof net

Restore the dust - proof net and the cover plate in the reverse order of disassembly to ensure a secure installation.

#### Precautions:

- Avoid wiping the inside of the machine body or non washable dust proof nets directly with a
  wet cloth.
- It is recommended to clean once every 1 3 months, and shorten the cycle in a dusty environment.


1 Package includes screen, mounting hooks, adhesive strips




2 Unfold the screen and locate a desired position on the wall for installation. Mark the position of the grommets on the wall. Note: Please make sure to stretch tight to avoid wrinkling or sagging.



3 Remove the cover on one side of the adhesive strip and stick it to the back of the mounting hook. Make sure to align the hole on the mounting hook and the Adhesive strip.




4 Remove the other side of the adhesive strip and stick the mounting hook on the wall at the marked location from strp 1. Make sure the mounting hook hole is aligned with the marked location.



5 Mount the screen onto the mounting hooks. It is recommended to use 5 mounting hooks. For easy removal of mounting hooks, slowly stretch the adhesive strip straight down using the tab with downward facing arrows. Note: The adhesive strips should not be used on textured walls, wallpaper, brick, non-stick surfaces, or fabrics.


#### **Outdoor Installation Instructions**



Thread the ropes (not included) through the grommets located at the top and bottom of the screen.



2 Loop the rope twice through the final grommet on each comer so the screen will stay tight.



3 Tie both ends of the two ropes tonearby bced ob jects, like trees, as shown in the diagram. Note: When the screen is not in use. please store in this bag to keep the screen clean and prevent discoloration from UV rays due to prolonged Sun exposure.
